

The manufacturing process of Blended Tiles yields hybrid colors. These hybrids are tiles that cannot be replicated as an individual color as they are derived from the intentional cross-contamination of the blend's primary colors. When selling a blend it is important that the customer sees samples that exhibit these characteristics and/or views an installed roof. If the customer wants a blend run as separate colors, this can be done at an up-charge and must be ordered as such.

Even with our stringent quality control standards, product shade variations will occur. This shading, when properly blended throughout the roof, contributes considerably to the uniqueness of every concrete tile roof.

To achieve the most pleasing appearance of the completed roof, tile stacks should be made up of tile taken randomly from several pallets. Similarly, tile setters should take tile randomly from several stacks and use their best judgment as craftsmen to blend the various shades. This practice, along with periodically examining work in progress from a distance, will serve to reduce the potential for "Hot Spots" and streaking and will optimize the effect of the product shade variations.
